

1) Eligibility

- The PhD student concerned must be registered at Nantes University, IMT Atlantique or Gustave Eiffel University in the Graduate School “Matter, Molecules, Materials and Geosciences (3MG)”.
- Mobility grants can be awarded for the following participations:
 - Conferences (if you are author of an oral communication or a poster)
 - Training schools
 - Scientific collaborations with a foreign laboratory
 - Immersion training in a foreign laboratory
- Travel to the partner laboratory is not eligible for thesis in co-supervision.

2) Financial support

- A maximum grant is offered depending of the destination:
 - €350 in France
 - €500 in Europe (including UK)
 - €800 outside Europe
- Co-financing must be offered by the research unit or by the host organization.
- The same PhD student cannot benefit from more than one support during the year.
- Funding is not guaranteed and will depend on available budget. A PhD student who has already benefited from a support in the past will not be a priority.

3) Calendar

- The mobility must be carried out before December 31, 2024.
- The PhD student concerned will have to anticipate its request and send its application before the following dates so that it can be studied by the commission:
 - February 20
 - April 10
 - June 20
 - August 28
- The candidate and the research unit will receive a response within one week after the date mentioned above.

4) Payments

- The funding will be paid to the research unit which will cover the PhD student's travel.
- At the end of the mobility, the following documents must be presented:
 - Copy of transport tickets
 - Report describing the benefit of mobility (2 pages max)
 - For conferences: conference program identifying the title and author of the communication AND abstract in A4 format with the Nantes Métropole logo (mobility funder)

- For scientific collaborations or immersion training: letter of invitation OR certificate of attendance signed by the host institution
- For training schools: certificate of participation

5) Submission

- The attached application file must be completed and signed by the PhD student, the thesis supervisor and the director of the research unit.
